Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by Wednesday, 24 August 2022 at 12:00 hrs BWF Headquarters time.

If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday, 25 August 2022 at 23:59 hrs BWF Headquarters time, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections will be entertained after this point.

Online Entry – Hosting Member Association Entries

Eligible players wishing to enter through the hosting Member Association must follow a different process for international entries.

- Entry is open to any current member of Badminton Canada in good standing with a BWF # ID number. Please note that only Canadian players with a BWF # ID registered in the BWF Active Player Database can be entered by Badminton Canada. Badminton Canada is implementing its Online Entry System for this tournament.
- Players who intend to register for this tournament must ensure that they have a working email to receive a payment and entry confirmation email.
- All Canadian players will be required to pay a Canadian Anti-Doping Program (CADP) fee as requested by Badminton Canada at the time of online registration.

Entry Deadline:

The entry deadline for Badminton Canada members is **Tuesday, 16 August, 2022 2359 hrs. MST**. No late entries will be accepted.

Entry Fee:

- The entry fee for one or two events is \$230.00 per player; for three events it is \$280.00 per player. Full entry fee must be paid online at the time of registration.
- No other forms of payment will be accepted.

Confirmation of Entry & Payment:

- Registering players will receive an email confirmation generated by the Badminton Canada Online Entry System and it will include: the events entered and for doubles, partners selected as well as the amount paid online.
- Receipt of payment and entry confirmation email is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline.

Refunds:

- For withdrawals done after the deadline of Monday, 5 September 2022, no refunds will be made.
- Entry fees will only be refunded for non-placement in the draws.

Canadian Entries:

- Canadian entries will be entered into the draws in order based on: BWF ranking, Badminton Canada ranking and random draw by BWF.
- Placement in the draws, including qualifications, is not guaranteed due to the maximum entry limits.

Withdrawals

The management of withdrawals will be run in accordance with BWF GCR 13 and 14.

Member Associations can withdraw their entries through the BWF Online Group Entry system until the last date of withdrawal without penalty (see Key Dates Section).

Withdrawals made after this date will incur a penalty in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5).

Please ensure that the Tournament Referee and Host Organizer are notified immediately in writing, clearly stating the reason for the withdrawal.

To qualify as a fully vaccinated traveller, you must have received, at least 14 calendar days by the day you travel:

- at least 2 doses of a vaccine accepted by the Government of Canada for the purpose of travel
- or a mix of 2 accepted vaccines
- or at least 1 dose of the Janssen/Johnson & Johnson vaccine

ArriveCan App

Checklist of what you need to have ready at the border

To enter or return to Canada as a fully vaccinated traveller, you must follow all of these requirements.

- ArriveCAN receipt with letter A, I, or V beside the vaccinated traveler's name
- Proof of vaccination that was uploaded into ArriveCAN (original or paper copy)
- Prepare for arrival testing if selected
- Travel document entered in ArriveCAN (e.g. passport)

Pre-entry tests are not required for fully vaccinated travelers entering Canada by land, air or water. You must still use ArriveCAN within 72 hours before your arrival to Canada.

Unvaccinated and partially vaccinated children under the age of 12 are not required to provide a valid pre-entry test result, if they are accompanying a fully vaccinated adult.

Children who are less than 5 years old are not required to test, regardless of their vaccination status.

A COVID-19 RT-PCR Test during the tournament is not mandatory for Super 100 Tournaments for players, team officials, and selected tournament staff and volunteers.
