## Online Entry – Hosting Member Entries

Eligible player wishing to enter through the hosting Member must follow a different process to international entries.

- Entry is open to any current member of Badminton Canada in good standing with a BWF # ID number. Please note that only Canadian players with a BWF # ID registered in the BWF Active Player Database can be entered by Badminton Canada. Badminton Canada is implementing its Online Entry System for this tournament.
- Players who intend to register for this tournament must ensure that they have a working email to receive a payment and entry confirmation email.
- All Canadian players will be required to pay a Canadian Anti-Doping, Registration and Insurance fee as requested by Badminton Canada at the time of online registration.

### Entry Deadline:

The entry deadline for Badminton Canada members is **Monday, 19-May-2024 at 2359 hrs. MST**. No late entries will be accepted.

### Entry Fee:

- The entry fee for Canadian athletes is a flat rate of \$275 CDN. Full entry fee must be paid online at the time of registration.
- No other forms of payment will be accepted.

### Confirmation of Entry & Payment:

- Registering players will receive an email confirmation generated by the Badminton Canada Online Entry System and it will include: the events entered and for doubles, partners selected as well as the amount paid online.
- Receipt of payment and entry confirmation email is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline.

### Refunds:

- For withdrawals done after the deadline of Monday, 19-May-2024, no refunds will be made.
- Entry fees will only be refunded for non-placement in the draws.

### Canadian Entries:

Canadian entries will be entered into the draws in order based on: BWF ranking, Badminton Canada ranking and random draw by BWF. Placement in the draws, including qualifications, is not guaranteed due to the maximum entry limits.

## Withdrawals

The management of withdrawals will be run in accordance with BWF GCR 13 and 14.

Members can withdraw their entries through the BWF Online Group Entry system until the last date of withdrawal without penalty (see Key Dates Section).

Withdrawals made after this date will incur a penalty in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5).

**Presentation Ceremonies**

All prize ceremonies will take place on Sunday, 7 July 2024, immediately after the conclusion of each final. Medals/trophies/other will be presented to all champions and finalists.

In accordance with Player Commitment Regulations (BWF Statute 5.3.6), all players participating in the finals of a tournament must attend the final ceremonies directly after the match or must follow the instructions given by the organizers regarding ceremony protocol.

No equipment, including rackets and flags will be allowed to be brought onto the podium. Clothing worn during the ceremony must be in accordance with the BWF GCR.

**Accreditation**

Access to Tournament venues and other services is provided through personalized and photographic accreditation. To facilitate the on-site registration process upon your arrival – we ask that all requests are made prior to the deadline of 11 June 2024.

The number of complimentary accreditations passes available for Team Officials is dependent on the number of competing player(s) from the same Member:

A limited number of additional accreditations passes for approved Team Officials will be available for purchase at a fee of USD\$200 charged to the respective Member, and payable at the tournament.

The fee to replace any lost or damaged accreditation passes will be USD\$100 on each occasion, charged to the respective Member.

The tournament reserves the right to refuse entry into any accredited venue or area or service (e.g. transportation) because of damaged or missing accreditation.

The fraudulent use of accreditation is strictly prohibited, and will result in access rights being removed, and penalties being applied.

## Anti-Doping

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out- of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

## Badminton Integrity

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).
